

# TAX SEASON SIMPLIFIED

# Tax Forms **Explained**



Salary, Medicare, Social Security, State and Federal Income tax withheld, retirement and Health Insurance

Payments made to contractors and vendors of over \$600 in the calendar year

1099–NEC, Formerly called 1099-MISC

**Corporate Federal** business tax return.

More advanced than your previous Schedule C

Profits or loss from business for each owner beyond the salary taken.

# keep in mind

\* Tax season year is based on the year the tax is paid for (Jan - Dec). So in this year, we will complete the previous year's tax season.

\*\* We file 1120-S extension by default for all Formations customers as best practice. It helps us avoid penalties, and allows us to "ping" the IRS system to check for potential issues. You should still aim to file on time regardless, unless you have a reason to file later. Completing your 1120–S is required to complete your 1040.
